Registration at the University

At your arrival in Naples please send an email to incoming@unina.it to be registered at the University

If you will start Erasmus mobility attending the courses from your own country, please let us know with an email and we will register you so that you can access the university tools. If at a later time you will come here in Naples to continue the semester, please send an email to inform us of your arrival.

After the registration you will receive a certificate with your student number and PIN code.

The International Office will fill in and sign all the documents requested by your University. For signing the Learning Agreement and other information about courses you need to contact your Academic coordinators.



Access to the UNIAITTools

In order to acces the University Information Technology System, international/Erasmus students need to activate their institutional email ... @ studenti.unina.it following these steps:

- I. Go to https://www.idm.unina.it/UninaPswMngt/loginPuk;
- 2. Carry out a login entering user key (Codice Fiscale) and PIN;
- 3. Once logged-in, account and institutional e-mail box will be visible;
- 4. Click on the indicated link the page to change the password to associate to the mailbox will be displayed;
- 5. Push "save" to save information or "cancel" to cancel them.



Access to the UNIAITTools

Once activated your email you can access the University Wi-Fi connection, the reserved student area of docenti.unina.it and Microsoft Teams.

DocentiUnina (www.docenti.unina.it) is a tool that allows electronic connection between teachers and students. Through this service, Federico II professors will share information, materials and documents with students.

Codice Fiscale

The Codice Fiscale is the tax code in Italy. This is an alphanumeric code consisting of 16 characters. It is the only way to identify unambiguously individuals and it is necessary for several purposes, e.g. open a bank account, receive payments or scholarships, etc...

Send an email to the International Welcome Desk (<u>internationalwelcomedesk@unina.it</u>), the ONLY company in charge of welcoming foreign students and researchers.

They will assist you in obtaining fiscal code.



PINcode and exams

The PIN (Personal Identification Number) is a code necessary for the exams digital registration. You will receive it as soon as you will register at University of Naples Federico II.

Please remember to provide the PIN every time you will pass an exam, even if it is a written one.

Otherwise your exam will not be registered.

Access to the Mcrosoft Teams

If you don't have an Office 365 account, please follow the registration instructions at https://softwaresso.unina.it

If you have an Office365-Unina account with your account (account@studenti.unina.it) go to the following link to sign-in https://www.office.com/

Attention: ONLY USE «Account aziendale o dell'istituto di istruzione»

To access the Office 365 Unina suite you need to get an account as described above. If you sign in with credentials acquired autonomously from Microsoft portal or Windows credentials, you can't use all the features provided by Unina.



Access to the Mcrosoft Teams

Teams is available in web version or app Desktop version

You can access the web version here https://teams.microsoft.com/

The app Desktop option, is more complete than the web version. If you decide to use the web option (no installation required), you should use Chrome or the last EDGE version. For the app Desktop version, install and then launch the application, in order to enter with the credentials Office365 Unina (account @studenti.unina.it)

To start Teams you need to click on the icon in the app list you can find in Unina Office 365 main page



Attending classes with Microsoft Teams Meeting

If you are invited, a notification on Teams or an email will inform you that you are a member of a team.

You can ask to became a member of a team if you are not part of it but that you see it in the teams list. In that case, the owner of that team have to allow you to access that specific team.

The creator of a team can make a code and share it. If you receive a code, use it to access to the team with the option "Unisciti a un team o creane uno".

General safety rules

- If you have symptoms of acute respiratory infections (fever, cough, cold), DO NOT leave your house.
- When you are in the university common areas (classrooms, laboratories, common areas, etc) always wear a mask to protect your nose and mouth.

- PARTIES ARE FORBIDDEN. There will be fines from 400 to 1.000 euros for anyone attending illegal indoor gatherings.

- Students who have been in CLOSE CONTACT with someone who tested positive for COVID-19 can write an email to International Office: we will help you arrange a COVID-19 test
