As part of the TNE **HerIT4Future** project, mobility opportunities are available for teachers and students from Latin America.

The selection process is left to the selected universities: <u>Universidade Federal do Paraná</u>, <u>Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile</u> and <u>Universidad Católica de Santiago de Guayaquil</u> according to the following scheme:

- Heritage
- Health Law
- Sexual identity and measures against gender-based violence
- Artificial Intelligence
- Environmental law
- Criminal law
- Access to justice
- Migrations in legal perspective
- International law.

Project deadline

All mobilities funded within this project must be completed by 31 March 2026.

Instructions for Incoming Student's Selection (your University → **UniNA)**

- Eligibility: Mobilities are open to PhD candidates willing to do research activities and attend courses related to the WP4 Law between Heritage and Future
- Latin America universities are required to nominate students who will come to University of Naples Federico II.

Student selection procedure: We believe the selection of students is best carried out by your institution, as you better know your students' profiles and potential. However, for transparency and reporting purposes, we kindly ask you to provide:

- A detailed explanation of the selection procedure and criteria;
- A digital copy of all documents submitted by the applicants;
- The final selection report, officially signed and stamped.

Note: All documents related to HerIT4Future-funded activities must follow the TNE project's visual identity, graphic template and project codes attached to this email.

As nomination has been sent, UniNA will provide applicants further instructions for pre-arrival procedures and grant management.









Important deadlines for students nominations

- **Deadline for nominations:** September 24th, 2025. This is to let us manage the administrative procedures.
- Model for sending nominations:
 - <u>The nomination letter</u> to the UniNA scientific coordinator of the project (Prof. Carla Masi Doria, cmdoria@unina.it)
 - <u>The nomination letter + documentations</u> to UniNA Administrative Staff email addresses (<u>claudia.pone@unina.it</u>; raffaela.caccavale@unina.it).
 - The list of nominated students must have: name, surname, date of birth, nationality, email address, name of the PhD.

Instructions for Incoming Staff Selection (your University → **UNINA)**

As for Teaching staff mobilities, we kindly ask you to share the nomination of the selected candidates at least **20 days before the starting of the mobility and to send to us also his/her nomination letter**, specifying that the nominated professor will carry out the mobility within the **HerIT4Future** project.

As nomination has been sent, UniNA will provide you applicants further instructions for pre-arrival procedures, and grant management.
