the ARTE@Protopisani - 2025/2026

The Apple Developer Academy ARTE (Advanced Research Track Experience)

GIVEN the Law of August 2nd, 1990, n. 241 “Nuove norme in materia di procedimento amministrativo e di diritto di accesso ai documenti amministrativi” [“New regulations on administrative procedures and the right of access to administrative documents”] and subsequent amendments and/or additions;

GIVEN the applicable University Statute;

GIVEN the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data - hereinafter EU Regulation 2016/679 - relating to the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, and the related National legislation of the Code regarding the protection of personal data, Legislative Decree N. 196/2003, as modified and integrated by Legislative Decree No. 101/2018;

CONSIDERING the Regulation of the University of Naples Federico II regarding the processing of personal data, issued with D.R. 1226/2021;

CONSIDERING the Scientific and Technological Cooperation Agreement signed between Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II and Apple, for the establishment of the Developer Academy, for the training in the development of new applications and digital services, with the purpose – among others – to provide students admitted to the Apple Developer Academy with the necessary skills to become “developers” of innovative apps, i.e., professionals who can design, implement and commercialize innovative services on Apple technological platforms;

CONSIDERING that, as provided for by the aforesaid Scientific and Technological Cooperation Agreement and the Exhibit A – Project Addendum 1, is established a training course called “The Pier”;

GIVEN the Administration Board decree of 25th July 2016 and subsequents with which the administrative and accounting management has been entrusted to the Centro di Servizio



di Ateneo per il Coordinamento dei Progetti Speciali e l'Innovazione Organizzativa dell'Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II – COINOR;

CONSIDERING also that, for the academic year 2025/2026 a total number of 18 students are expected to be admitted to attend ARTE – Advanced Research Track Experience program after passing a specific selection.

DECLARES

SECTION 1

(Announcement and number of seats)

The University of Naples Federico II announces a selection of 18 students to be admitted to the ARTE – Advanced Research Track Experience Program at the Apple Developer Academy. The selection refers to the academic year 2025/2026.

SECTION 2

(Requirements for participation)

To be eligible for selection under Art.1, applicants must have successfully completed the training at the Apple Developer Academy in Naples or another Apple Developer Academy with training programs of equal length (min 9 months) in Brazil, Indonesia, South Korea, USA, KSA and must not have participated in The Pier and ARTE program at the Apple Developer Academy in Naples in previous years.

Candidates get a provisional admission to the selection. The University might decide to exclude any candidate, at any stage of this selection procedure, if the requirements are not fully met.

SECTION 3

(Application for participation in the selection procedure)

The 18 positions advertised are divided by skill profile as follows:

- App Developer: 12
- App Designer: 6

The application form must be submitted exclusively on-line through the following website: <https://airtable.com/appdTkVIn0opQdB7g/shrJfOk6v251vjhgI>. On-line registration is available since the publication date of this announcement, and will close mandatorily (and under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure) at 12.00 (CEST) of May 30th 2025.

Failure to comply with the regulations will prevent the admission to the selection and, in any case, result in an exclusion from the procedure.

All communications concerning the selection will be given exclusively via on-line publication on the Official Noticeboard of the University of Naples Federico II (available at the University website www.unina.it) and by publication on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

SECTION 4

(Evaluation Committee)

The Evaluation Committee will be appointed after the final deadline for submission of the applications. Its composition will be announced through a notice, published exclusively in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

SECTION 5

(Selection procedure)

The selection procedure will consist in an evaluation of the presented documentation based on the criteria indicated in point 4 of Annex A and in a technical/motivational interview to be conducted remotely.

SECTION 6

(Publication of the ranking list)

The merit ranking list will be drawn up on the basis of the scores obtained through the evaluation.

The final ranking list will be published exclusively in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

The final ranking will be published before June 13th, 2025. In the event of a tie, the younger candidate shall prevail. The selection procedure refers only to academic year 2025-2026.

SECTION 7

(Tuition fees and economic support funds)

Selected applicants will have to pay NO tuition fees to get enrolled in the ARTE project at the Apple Developer Academy.

Furthermore, for the past edition of the project, attendance allowances have been provided to the selected applicants by Regione Campania, within the framework of EU-funded initiatives.

If funding is available for the upcoming year, applicants who successfully complete the ARTE



experience will be eligible to receive financial support in the form of the above-mentioned attendance allowance. This support will be subject to conditions established by the Granting Authority (European Commission). Consequently, ARTE students will be required to provide the Administration Office with any necessary documentation to demonstrate compliance with the requirements set by the European Commission.

SECTION 8

(Procedure of acceptance)

The admitted candidates have to formalize their attendance to the Apple Developer Academy by signing an agreement with which the admitted person undertakes to comply with the provisions of this selection notice.

Once the deadline for acceptance has expired, if there are any places left due to lack of acceptance or subsequent withdrawal, the ranking will be scrolled, in accordance with the required profile and the project involved. Any scrolling and the relative terms for making acceptances will be made known exclusively by the publication on the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

SECTION 9

(Publication of the procedural acts)

This notice of selection and all documents attached will be published exclusively in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

The online publication in the Official website of Apple Developer Academy has the force of notification with all effects and no personal messages will be sent to interested parties.

Therefore, it is recommended a constant consultation of the web link above.

SECTION 10

(Access to documents, Information regarding personal data)

Applicants have access to documents concerning the competition procedure, in accordance with the current legislation. This right will be exercised in the manner prescribed by the University Regulations laying down the rules on administrative procedure and the right of access to documents, issued with the Chancellor Decree n. 2386/98 and subsequent amendments and additions.

SECTION 11

(Privacy and information on personal data)

In accordance with the art. 13 of the EU Regulation 679/2016, the personal data collected will be



processed for the purposes of the procedure for which they are released and will be used exclusively for this purpose and in any case within the Institutional activities of the University. The data controller is the University of Naples Federico II, in the persons of the Rector and the General Manager, in relation to their skills. (Final Provisions)

The University reserves the right to exclude at any time the applicants participating in the procedure pursuant to this notice for failure to comply with its provisions or within the time specified or for default of the applicants' requirements. The exclusions are made with a Chancellor's Decree. Exclusions will be notified exclusively by online publication in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.
